Hanoi, Halong Bay, Hue, Hoi An, Nha Trang, Ho Chi Minh City, Can Tho, Siem Reap

## ITINERARY

### Day 1: Hanoi Arrival

Depart from your home to Hanoi – Vietnam's Capital.

On arrival at the airport you'll be met by our tour guide and transferred to your hotel for check-in. Free at leisure and overnight in Hanoi.

**Meal:** In-flight Meals.

**Accommodation:** The Q Hotel 4\* or similar

### Day 2: Hanoi - Halong Bay -

After breakfast, you will travel by coach through the rich farm land of the Red River Delta to arrive at Halong Bay. Designated a World Heritage site in 1994, Halong Bay's spectacular array of islands, dotted with wind and wave eroded grottoes, is a wonder to behold.

On arrival you board a ship to view the thousands of limestone islands and their caves of all shapes and sizes. The sails of junks and sampans gliding across the clear emerald waters of the bay form a magnificent scene. You'll also have the opportunity to visit some of the hidden grottoes beneath the towering cliffs.

**Meal:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

**Accommodation:** Oriental Sails or similar

### **Day 3: Halong Bay - Hanoi**

Early risers may like to participate in Tai Chi on the top deck or simply relax and enjoy the sunrise over the bay's towering islands. A sight not to be missed- especially if you are into photography. Enjoy a morning cup of coffee or tea, before setting out to explore nearby islands. Return to the junk for breakfast, then take advantage of the sundeck and admire the amazing rock formations of Halong Bay.

In the afternoon our driver will meet you at the Halong Jetty to drive you back to Hanoi.

**Meal:** Brunch.

**Accommodation:** The Q Hotel 4\* or similar

### **Day 4: Hanoi City Tour - Hue**

After breakfast, you will take a city tour of Hanoi to explore attractions such as the Temple of Literature, Vietnam's first university, Ho Chi Minh Complex – Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum (photo stop only), One Pillar Pagoda and Tran Quoc Pagoda (one of the oldest pagodas in Vietnam). Later you will board a short flight to Hue.

On arrival, you will be met at Hue airport and transferred to your hotel for check-in.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

**Accommodation:** Romance Hotel Hue 4\* or similar

### **Day 5: Hue City Tour**

This morning, we visit the Imperial Citadel. This was the center of power for the Nguyen Dynasty who ruled between 1802 and 1945. Here, we will visit Flag Tower, Noon Gate, Nine Tripod Cauldrons, Nine Holy Cannons, Thai Hoa Palace, and the Forbidden Purple City.

Later, you'll be boarding a boat for a wonderful trip on the Perfume River and a visit to Thien Mu pagoda.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

**Accommodation:** Romance Hotel Hue 4\* or similar

### **Day 6: Hue - Danang - Hoi An**

Today, you will leave Hue behind you as you make your way to Hoi An via Danang.

We also suggest you to visit Golden Bridge if you would like and we offer this highlights optional.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

**Accommodation:** Silk Village Resort 4\* or similar

### **Day 7: Hoi An Walking Tour**

In the morning, there's a guided tour to explore Hoi An on foot which takes in a visit to an old merchant's home; Hoi An Market; a local Chinese temple and the Japanese Covered Bridge – the bridge was first constructed in the 1590s by the Japanese community to link them with the Chinese quarters. Over the centuries the ornamentation has remained relatively faithful to the original Japanese design. The French flattened out the roadway for cars, but the original arched shape was restored in 1986.

### **Day 8: Hoi An**

Today, you are free time at leisure to explore the Ancient Quarter or head to the beach/swimming pool for relaxing.

### **Day 9: Hoi An - Da Nang - Nha Trang**

Today you take the short flight to Nha Trang, a famous beach city of Vietnam. On arrival in Nha Trang, you will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

**Accommodation:** Em Oi Hotel Nha Trang 4\* or similar

### **Day 10: Nha Trang City tour**

Nha Trang city, a small city on the south central coastline of Vietnam, is a famous beach city of Vietnam. Travelers like to travel to Nha Trang, not because of its beach, but also by its historical relics from Cham civilization represented as Po Nagar tower, a sacred Hindu site dating back to the 7th century, Stone Church built in French colony time, to Long Son Pagoda – Buddhist pagoda built in commemoration of the monks and nuns who died

whilst fighting the Diem Government.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

**Accommodation:** Em Oi Hotel Nha Trang 4\* or similar

#### **Day 11: Nha Trang**

Spend your free day to relax for swimming or explore the city as you wish.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

#### **Day 12: Nha Trang - Ho Chi Minh City**

After breakfast, you will check out your hotel and take a flight to Ho Chi Minh City.

On arrival, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Spend your free time at leisure and overnight in Ho Chi Minh City.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

**Accommodation:** Silverland Jolie Hotel 4\* or similar

#### **Day 13: Ho Chi Minh City - Cu Chi Tunnels**

After breakfast, we continue on to Cu Chi Tunnels. During the Vietnam War, guerrilla fighters built a labyrinth of narrow tunnels, using them to hide in during bombing raids and to stage surprise attacks. Today, the remaining tunnels have become a major tourist attraction, giving visitors a unique understanding of what life was like during the Vietnam War.

In the afternoon, you will have a half day tour of Ho Chi Minh City with highlights such as: visit War Remnant Museum, take photo outside Notre Dame Cathedral, Post Office, and soaking up the atmosphere at Ben Thanh market, one of Ho Chi Minh's liveliest areas.

**Meal:** Breakfast, Lunch.

**Accommodation:** Silverland Jolie Hotel 4\* or similar

#### **Day 14: Ho Chi Minh City - Mekong Delta - Can Tho**

In Southern Vietnam, Mekong River unravels into nine sprawling rivers, forming the fertile Mekong Delta. It's here the river rules. Daily life flows with the ever-changing waters, fisheries thrive during the annual flood and rice fields are quickly dug as the waters recede.

Depart Ho Chi Minh City after breakfast, driving two-hours to reach Cai Be in the heart of the Mekong Delta for one of the highlights of the tour – a cruise on the mighty Mekong River and the chance to witness life on and around the water of the “Nine Dragon River”. Board a traditional wooden sampan boat around the Cai Be Floating Market, a commercial spectacle established in the 19th century. Marvel at boats replete with exotic produce and interact with locals in order to discover more about their stock. Next, disembark and stroll to the coconut candy factory to discover the manufacturing process of the sweet treats, as well as puffed rice – the local equivalent of popcorn. A delicious home-cooked Vietnamese meal will be served for lunch in a local family. Then take a walk through their fruit orchard to see the fresh seasonal fruits on the trees and listen to melodious Vietnamese folk music known as “Don Ca Tai Tu”.

Reboard the boat through the narrow canals around the island, appreciating the tranquility and lush landscapes of this part of the Delta, to Vinh Long. Drive to the largest city in the Mekong Delta: Can Tho, a buzzing town with a lively waterfront and a colorful mix of narrow back streets that make for some rewarding exploration. Rest of the day, you may like to walking along Ninh Kieu Park and on a pedestrian bridge of Can Tho City.

**Meal:** Breakfast, Lunch.

**Accommodation:** IRIS Hotel Can Tho 4\* or similar

#### **Day 15: Can Tho - Ho Chi Minh City**

After breakfast, you are free time at leisure to explore the mystery of Can Tho.

Later, check out hotel and transferd back to Ho Chi Minh City.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

**Accommodation:** Silverland Jolie Hotel 4\* or similar

#### **Day 16: Saigon - Siem Reap**

After breakfast, you are free till we drive to the airport for flight to the mystery city of Cambodia, Siem Reap.

Upon arrival to the airport you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is at leisure to explore this vibrant city.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

**Accommodation:** Paradise Angkor Hotel 4\* or similar

### **Day 17: Siem Reap - Angkor Temples**

Spend a full day discovering the mystical Angkor temples. Your day starts with a visit to Angkor Wat, then we will visit the ancient Ta Prohm Monastery.

In the afternoon, visit Angkor Thom (the Great City) beginning by the south gate and the famous Bayon of the 12th and 13th centuries. Then, journey to the Elephant Terrace and the raised Leper King Terrace, built in the 12th century and which features many beautifully sculptured Apsaras.

**Meal:** Breakfast. Lunch.

**Accommodation:** Paradise Angkor Hotel 4\* or similar

### **Day 18: Siem Reap**

Today, you are free time at leisure to explore the mystery of Siem Reap or swimming at hotel.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

**Accommodation:** Paradise Angkor Hotel 4\* or similar

### **Day 19: Siem Reap - Home**

Today you will be transported to Siem Reap airport for your flight to home.

**Meal:** Breakfast.

### FLIGHT INFORMATION

This package includes international flights from Sydney/Melbourne and surcharge from Adelaide, Brisbane, Perth or other city if requested when selecting your departure city.

#### Interstate Surcharge

Surcharge of **\$400** for departures from Adelaide & Brisbane & and **\$300** for departures from Sydney

In this packages, we will use some different airlines such as: Vietnam Airlines, Vietjet Air or similar airlines (20kg for checked baggage per passenger and 7kg hand luggage per passenger, 01-piece check-in baggage).

- Some flights will require a minimum of 1 transit (maximum 2).
- All tickets will include 20 kilos checked baggage per person, along with 7 kilos of hand luggage.
- Despite the airlines baggage allowance, we recommend travelling with 20 kilos per person due to restrictions with internal flights (where applicable), as well as coach and train transportation. Also, you will be responsible for handling your luggage at all times as the services of porters is not included. If travelling over this amount, you will be liable for any excess baggage fees enforced by the airline, payable direct.
- Once ticketed, flights are non-refundable. Any changes will be subject to the airline rules, Airline change fees and an Asia Vacation Group change fee of \$250 per person.
- Full names as per passport (including all middle names) are required. Any error in the names submitted will be subject to an Asia Vacation Group name change fee of \$150 plus any applicable fees charged by the airline, or the ticket may be non-refundable with the purchase of a new ticket required.
- Any airline schedule changes or cancellations are beyond our control. It is important that you, as the customer, stay up-to-date with the latest airline schedule information prior to your departure. If a schedule change results in extended transits or an earlier/later departure from your destination, any additional accommodation or alternative arrangements will be at the traveler's expense.
- Any airline 'extras' such as pre-allocated seating is at your own arrangement (additional charges apply)
- After booking, the price payable may be subject to change as a result of factors beyond the control of Asia Vacation Group. Asia Vacation Group reserves the right to increase the price payable and this will be reflected on the customer's invoice. Increases may be in relation to, but not limited to, currency fluctuations, airline taxes, airfare increases and fuel surcharges.

- In the event of that you no-show on your scheduled flight, please be aware the airline will require you to pay a no show fee, Airline reissue fee plus any additional airfare and taxes. Asia Vacation Group will also charge a \$250 admin fee to assist re accommodating you on the next available flight. #### **Physical Requirements**
