### Day 1: Negombo Arrival

Welcome to Sri Lanka!

Upon arrival at the airport you will be met and transferred to your hotel for check-in.

The rest of the day is at leisure.

**Meals:** In-flight meals

**Accommodation:** Regal Reseau Hotel & Spa 4\* or similar

### Day 2: Negombo - Anuradhapura

After breakfast proceed to Anuradhapura and visit the ancient kingdom (170 km/4 hours). Anuradhapura, an ancient capital of Sri Lanka, is famous for its well-preserved ruins of the Great Sri Lankan Civilization. This UNESCO World Heritage site lies 205 km (127 mi) north of Colombo, the current capital, in the North Central Province.

Founded in the 4th century BC, it was the capital of the Anuradhapura Kingdom until the 11th century AD. visit Mihintale (Approx of visit: 2 hours)

Mihintale is where Buddhism was first introduced in Sri Lanka. Mihintale is regarded as the cradle of Buddhism in Sri Lanka. The rock is filled with shrines and rock dwellings. A grand stairway of 1,840 steps made out of granite slabs 15" wide leads to the summit from where one could get a splendid view of the surrounding countryside.

**Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner

**Accommodation:** The Lake Forest Hotel 4\* or similar

**Tips & suggestions:** Dress modestly when visiting Anuradhapura's religious sites, wearing long pants and covering your shoulders. Sleeveless, transparent clothing, and shorts are not allowed.

### **Day 3: Anuradhapura - Sigiriya**

After breakfast, check out at the hotel and transfer to Sigiriya.

Alternatively, you may wish to join an optional tour of Minneriya National Park.

**Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner.

**Accommodation:** Tropical Life Resort & Spa 4\* or similar

**Please note:** Since elephants are migratory animals, we may substitute your visit to Wasgamuwa National Park or one of the surrounding Eco Parks to ensure we maximize your opportunity of seeing the elephants based on the elephant locations.

### **Day 4: Sigiriya - Lion Rock Fortress - Polonnaruwa - Sigiriya**

After early breakfast, you will climb the Sigiriya Rock Fortress (Lion's Rock), one of the most extraordinary artistic complexes of its time. This magnificent citadel, declared as a UNESCO heritage site in 1982, allures artistic and architectural curiosity from around the globe. Sigiriya is a rock fortress built in the 5th century A.D. This majestic Citadel in the sky was the refuge of King Kasyapa and is world-renowned for its 'Mirror Wall', which consists of poems and paragraphs carved by some of the thousands of visitors who visited the rock many years ago, and for its magnificent frescoes, like the Ajantha frescoes of India. After that, you will transfer to Polonnaruwa.

Along the way, experience the authentic flavors of Sri Lanka with a farmer's lunch prepared by a local family, showcasing the island's culinary traditions. Savor the taste of freshly prepared rice and curry dishes, carefully crafted using local ingredients. After lunch, drive to visit the Polonnaruwa Ancient Kingdom is Sri Lanka's second oldest kingdom and features a plethora of ruins and places of religious worship. Some of the many interesting places to visit in Polonnaruwa include the Gal Viharaya (Stone temple), Lankathilake, Thivanka Image House, Nissanka Latha Mandapaya, the Audience Hall and the Vatadage. Then return to the hotel.

**Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

**Accommodation:** Tropical Life Resort & Spa 4\* or similar

### **Day 5: Sigiriya - Dambulla - Kandy**

After breakfast, drive to Dambulla. Upon arrival, visit Dambulla Golden Cave Temple, designated as a world heritage site dating from the 1st century BC. Dambulla temple is located on a gigantic rock towering more than 160 m above the surrounding area. The Rock itself is more than 1.5 km around its base and the summit is at 550m. The caves on this rock were the refuge of King Walagamba when he was in exile for 14 years and feature a mixture of religious and worldly paintings and sculptures. Several reclining Buddha statues include the 15-meter-long sculpture of the Buddha which is carved to the rock.

Then proceed to Kandy city (90 km / 2 hours) enroute visit a Spice Garden in Matale. You will learn the ingredients for cooking curry, distinguish species, experience massage and shopping for some product nature stay here.

Thereafter, go ahead to Kandy City. Arrive at the hotel late this afternoon where the rest of the day is at leisure

**Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner

**Accommodation:** Hotel Topaz 4\* or similar

### **Day 6: Kandy Sightseeing**

Today you will explore the Kandy city tour by foot. Visit Central market, Old Bogambara Prison from outside, stroll around Kandy Lake will entice you to spend some time here. Also, visit the Temple of the Tooth Relic of the Buddha, the founder of Buddhism. The sacred relic was brought to Sri Lanka in the 4th century A.D. The sacred relic has ever since been the symbol of sovereignty for its ruler and is always enshrined in great splendor. Embark on a sightseeing tour in the city of Kandy. Thereafter, enjoy a typical Sri Lankan cultural performance.

**Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner.

**Accommodation:** Hotel Topaz 4\* or similar

**Tips & suggestions:** During the visit of Temple of the Tooth please wear clothing covering knees and shoulders, as

a sign of respect. You will also be required to leave your shoes at the shoe counter near to the entrance before entering the temple.

#### **Day 7: Kandy - Tea Factory - Nuwara Eliya**

After breakfast, you will leave for Nuwara Eliya.

Along the way, you will visit Peradeniya Botanical Gardens once enjoyed by a Kandyan queen; this rose garden is enclosed next to a large bend in the Mahaweli River. Residence of Kandyan princes in the 1st Century. There are 4,000 different plant species here, considered one of the most advanced in Asia.

Afternoon visit a tea plantation and a factory. Here you will enjoy the absolute tea experience, taking you from the moment the young tea leaves are plucked from the plantation to being processed in the factory to make a steamy cup of tea. If you are interested, the tea factory is the best place to purchase good quality tea. Next, proceed to Nuwara Eliya and admire the amazing views here. Arrive and check in to the hotel.

**Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner.

**Accommodation:** Lynden Grove Hotel 3\* or similar

**Tips & suggestions:** Please note you will be driving to an altitude of 1900 meters and therefore the temperature in Nuwara Eliya will be 20-25c during the day, and 10-15c during the night. Warm clothing is recommended.

#### **Day 8: Nuwara Eliya Free Day**

After breakfast, enjoy your time at leisure. For those adventure seekers, you may wish to join an optional hike to the incredibly scenic Horton's Plains and World's End

**Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner.

**Accommodation:** Lynden Grove Hotel 3\* or similar

#### **Day 9: Nuwara Eliya - Ella - Tissamaharama**

After breakfast, enjoy your time at leisure and check out at 10.00 am.

Thereafter, embark on one of South Asia's most famous train rides, The mystical train ride from Nanu Oya to Ella. The train journey from Nanu Oya to Ella in Sri Lanka is widely regarded as one of the most extraordinary and visually stunning experiences in the world. Spanning approximately 25 kilometers (15.5 miles), this scenic route traverses the captivating landscapes of Sri Lanka's hill country. As the train ascends gradually into the mountains, passengers are treated to breathtaking panoramic vistas of verdant tea plantations, ethereal valleys veiled in mist, captivating waterfalls, and dense forests teeming with life. Thereafter, you will transfer to Tissamaharama.

**Meals:** Breakfast, Dinner.

**Accommodation:** Chaarya Resort & Spa 4\* or similar

**Special note:** that it is not possible to confirm the train ticket reservation due to the fact that Sri Lanka Railway has a manual system for reservations. Tickets can only be booked 30 days prior to departure. On the rare occasion the train is fully booked we'll conduct the route by road.

#### **Day 10: Tissamaharama - Yala National Park - Mirissa Area**

Today, you are free at leisure or you can purchase our optional visit to Yala National Park.

Thereafter, drive to Mirissa and Weligama beach area. Stay overnight at the resort in Mirissa Area

**Accommodation:** Mandara Resort 4\* or similar

After check-out, you will be transferred to visit Galle Fort is a town situated on the southwestern tip of Sri Lanka, 119 km (74 mi) from Colombo. Galle was known as Gimhathiththa (although Ibn Batuta in the 14th century refers to it as Qali) before the arrival of the Portuguese in the 16th century, when it was the main port on the island. Galle reached the height of its development in the 18th century, before the arrival of the British, who developed the harbor at Colombo. Check in at the hotel and enjoy your stay here.

### **Day 13: Galle - Colombo**

Today you will transfer to Colombo city.

### FLIGHT INFORMATION

This package includes international flights from Sydney/Melbourne and surcharge from Adelaide, Brisbane, Perth or other city if requested when selecting your departure city.

### Interstate Surcharge

Surcharge of **\$400 for departures from Adelaide & Brisbane** and **\$500 for departures from Perth**

In this packages, we will use some different airlines such as: Sri Lanka Airlines, Malaysia Airlines, or similar (20/23kg for checked baggage per passenger and 7kg hand luggage per passenger, 01-piece check-in baggage).

**Some flights will require a minimum of 1 transit (maximum 2).**

All tickets will include 23 kilos checked baggage per person, along with 7 kilos of hand luggage.

Despite the airlines baggage allowance, we recommend travelling with 20 kilos per person due to restrictions with internal flights (where applicable), as well as coach and train transportation. Also, you will be responsible for handling your luggage at all times as the services of porters is not included. If travelling over this amount, you will be liable for any excess baggage fees enforced by the airline, payable direct.

Once ticketed, flights are non-refundable. Any changes will be subject to the airline rules, Airline change fees and an Asia Vacation Group change fee of \$250 per person.

Full names as per passport (including all middle names) are required. Any error in the names submitted will be subject to an Asia Vacation Group name change fee of \$150 plus any applicable fees charged by the airline, or the ticket may be non-refundable with the purchase of a new ticket required.

Any airline schedule changes or cancellations are beyond our control. It is important that you, as the customer, stay up-to-date with the latest airline schedule information prior to your departure. If a schedule change results in extended transits or an earlier/later departure from your destination, any additional accommodation or alternative arrangements will be at the traveler's expense.

Any airline 'extras' such as pre-allocated seating is at your own arrangement (additional charges apply)

After booking, the price payable may be subject to change as a result of factors beyond the control of Asia Vacation Group. An e-visa is required for entry into Sri Lanka. The Department of Immigration and Emigration launched a system called "Electronic Travel Authorization – ETA" in order to grant prior approval for a visa online for foreign nationals who visit Sri Lanka. You can visit <http://eta.gov.lk/slvisa/> to purchase your visa online.

E-Visa's are only valid for 30 days, so you can only apply closer to your travel dates. Please do not apply for your visa until you have your travel documentation. It will take 3 business days to be approved. The cost is US\$50 per person.

#### **Maldives**

A tourist visa is available on arrival for stays of 30 days or less.
